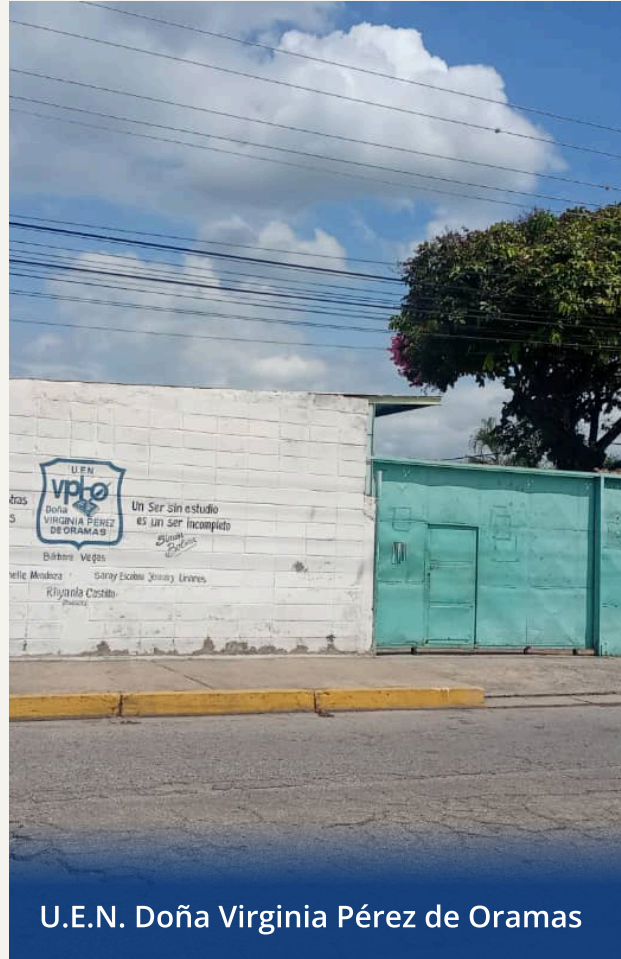

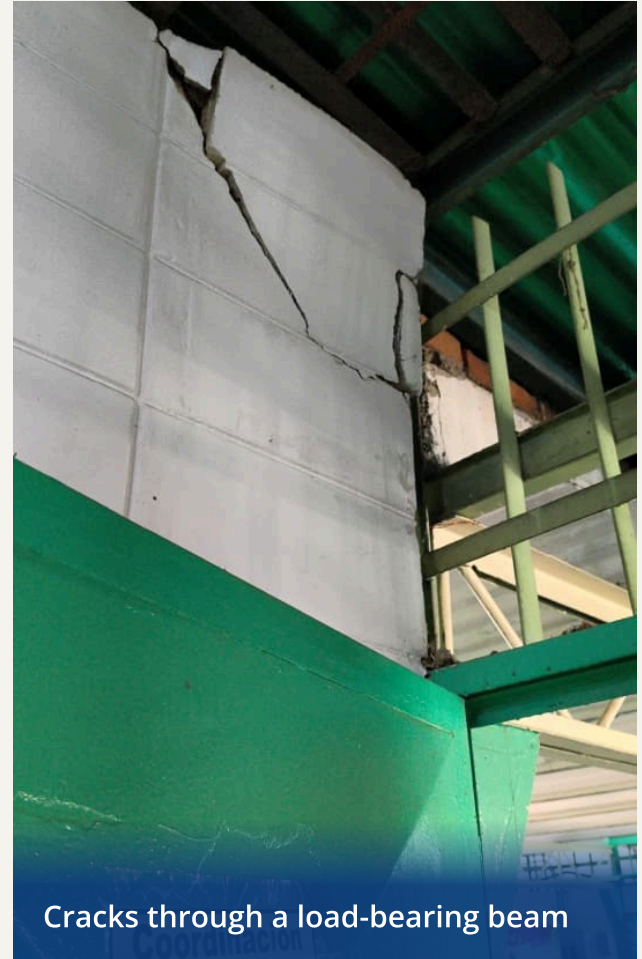

Requested by the camps themselves

MEDICAL & FIRST AID

Gloves, gauze, antiseptic

MEDICINES

Painkillers, antibiotics,
chronic-illness medication

FOOD & WATER

Drinking water, infant formula,
tinned fish

HYGIENE

Soap, nappies, sanitary pads

BEDDING

Sleeping mats, sheets, towels

REPAIRS

Rubble bags, sand, cement

SCHOOL & PLAY

Notebooks, crayons, small toys

CAMP KIT

Solar lanterns, flasks, cups

PICK ONE AND ACT TODAY
